3. Any special theme?

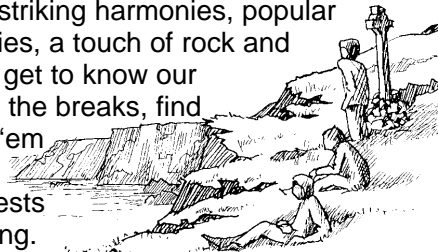
